



**Approved Credit Agreement with the Technical College System of Georgia  
(Those institutions accredited by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools)  
Policy for Transcription of Technical College System of Georgia Associate Degree credits to the  
BA Child Development Degree Completion Program.**

**Concordia University requires 128 credits of coursework in order to complete the Bachelor of Arts degree. Effective October 15, 2008, students who graduate with an Associate Degree in Early Childhood Care and Education from the Technical College System of Georgia and enter the online BA Child Development Degree Completion Program in the College of Education, may transfer in the following courses from those institutions accredited by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools.**

**Note: a review of transfer coursework will take place on an individual basis upon receipt of official transcripts.**
