

Move On When Ready Participation Permission Form

The Move on When Ready Program provides opportunities for high school juniors and seniors to enroll full-time in postsecondary institutions to earn both high school and college credits. *"Move on When Ready Act"; to provide for definitions; to provide a program for eleventh and twelfth grade students to attend postsecondary colleges and schools for high school credit; to provide for notice to parents and students of the program; to provide requirements for course credit; to provide for state funding; to provide for testing; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes. (O.C.G.A. Sec. 20-2-161.3)*

The program's guidelines and the student responsibilities have been explained and discussed with us and we clearly understand what is expected to be able to enroll and continue participation in this program.

Tuition, fees and materials are the only costs that MOWR FTE funding covers. All other expenses will be the student and parents/guardians responsibility to pay.
